Administrative Data

Data from response services is a measure of the number of women who report violence. It is the top of the coconut. To understand the extent of the issue, we must look beneath the surface.



Prevalence Data

Data from population-based surveys is a measure of the number of women in a population who have experienced intimate partner violence. This data captures information from women who have not reported their experience. It also captures information on demographic, economic, and social characteristics to help identify risk factors and inform interventions.
