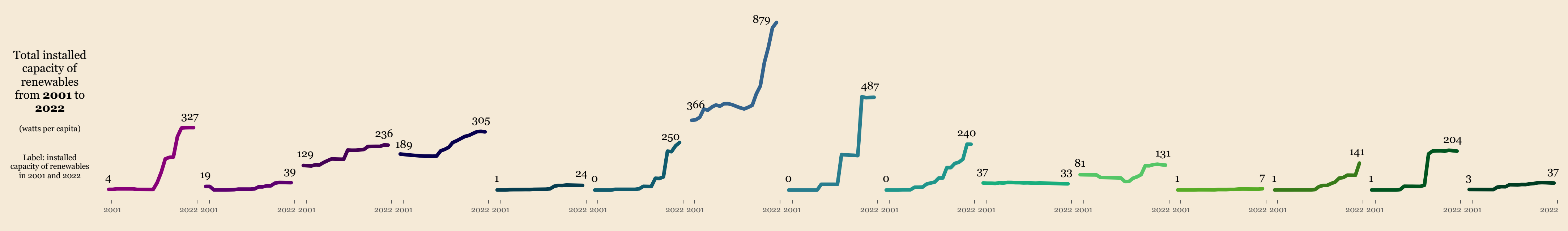
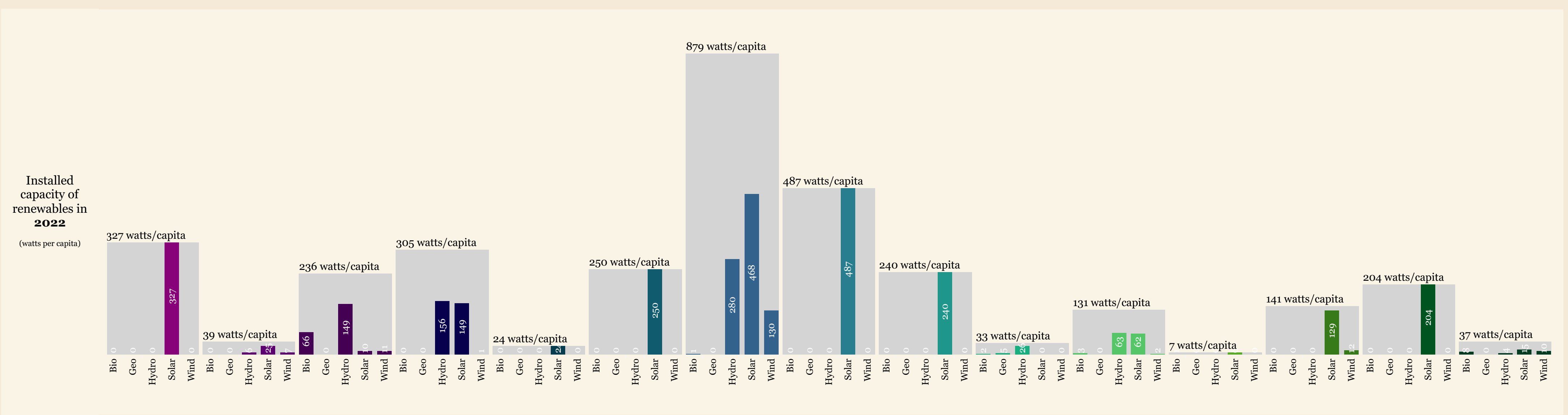
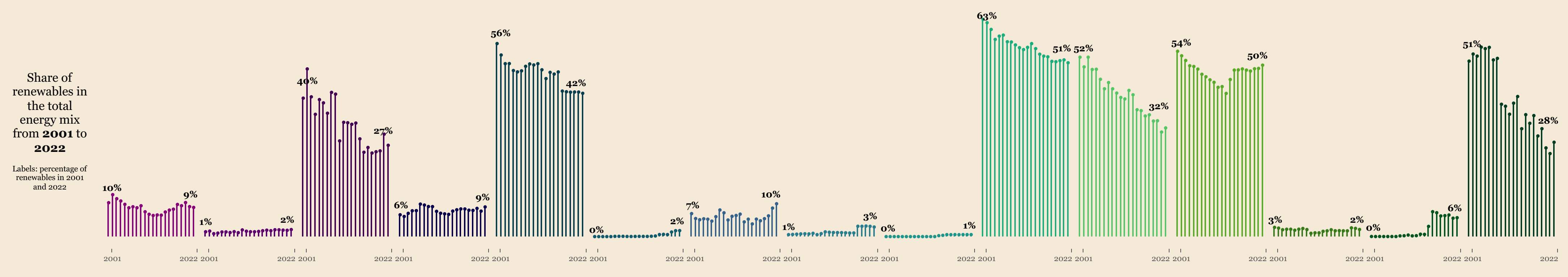
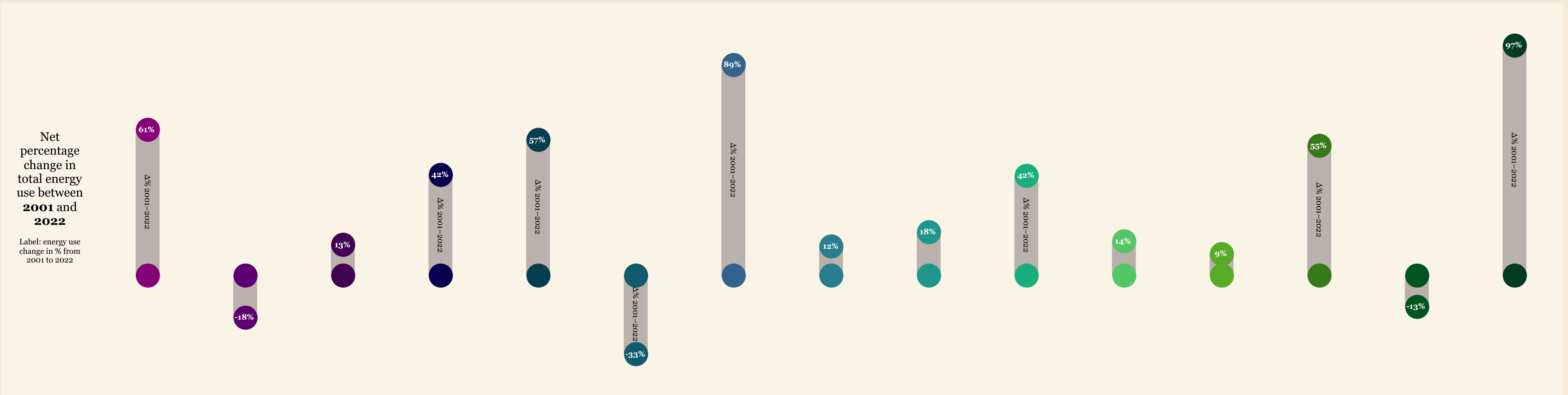
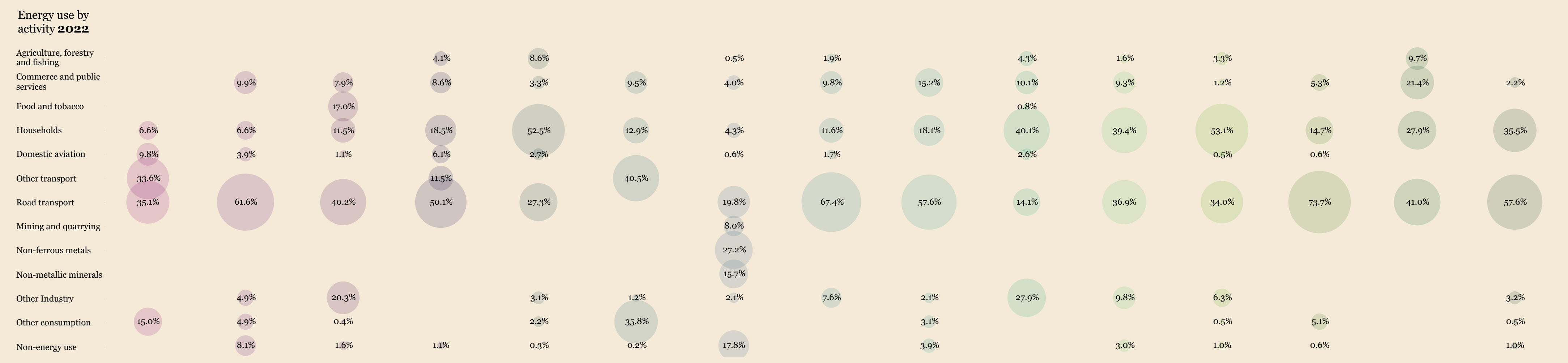
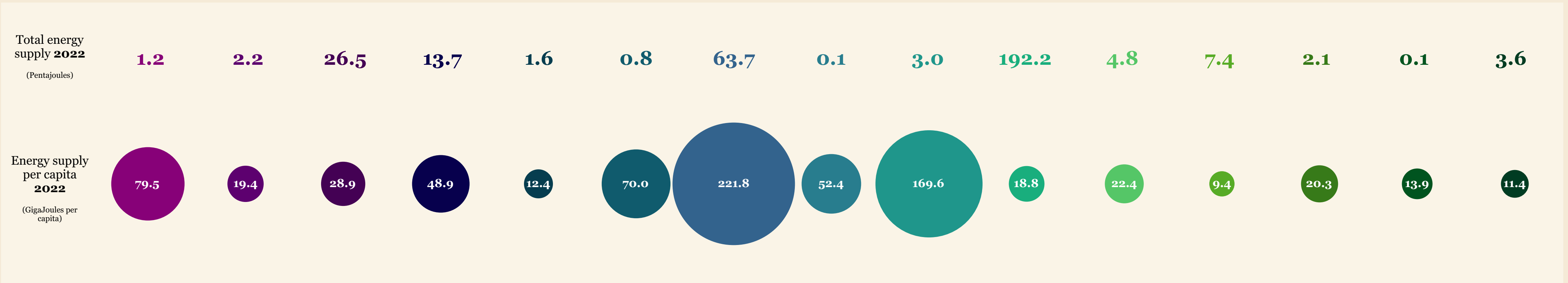
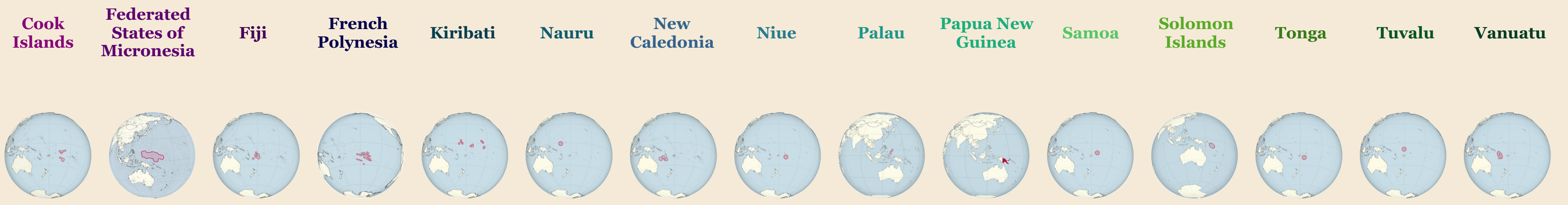


Islands of Change: A Rising Tide of Clean Energy
