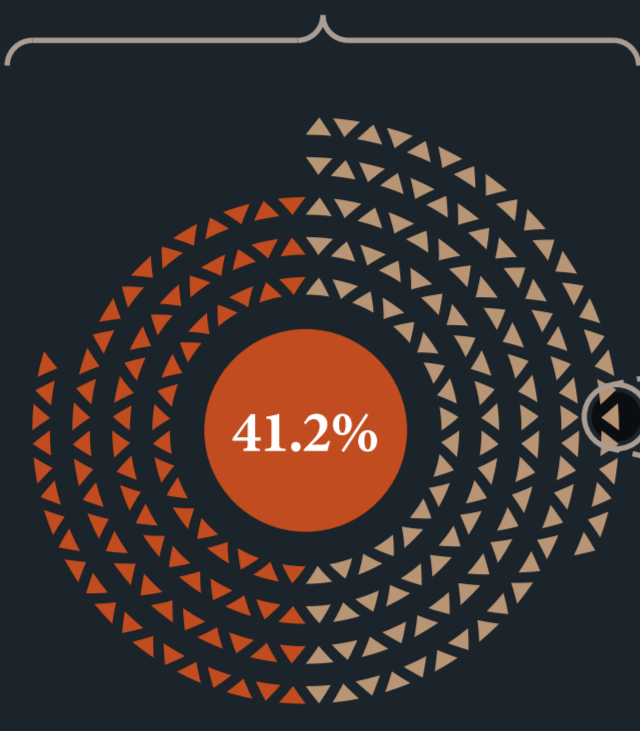


Trends in gender equality of the working population of Tonga

This infographic shows recent gender dynamics of the Tongan workforce. Included data is derived from the Pacific Data Hub* and contains occupational groups as defined in the aforementioned data source.

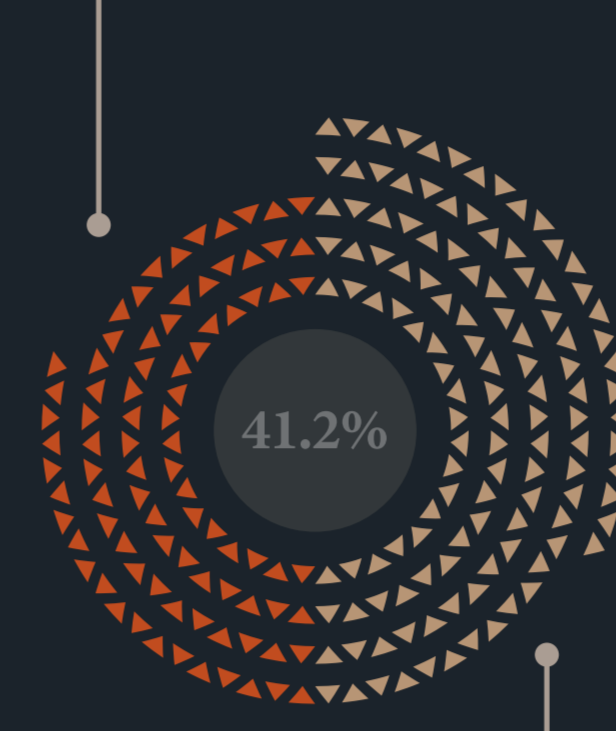
Legend

1. Labor participation data is depicted in a concentric circle design inspired by traditional Tongan Ngatu patterns.




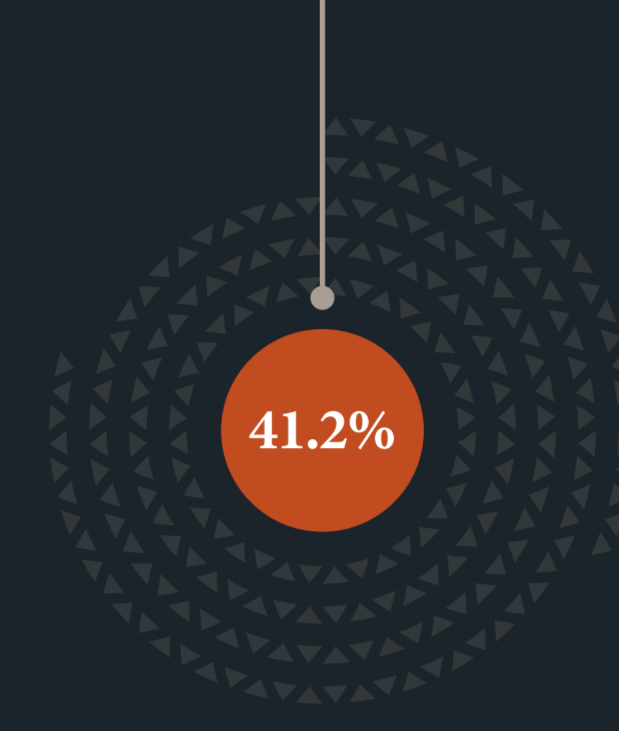
2. Each triangle within the concentric circle visualization corresponds to ten people. The sum of triangles equals to the rounded total number of workers within an occupational group.

3. Triangles at the left side indicate female workers.



4. Triangles at the right side indicate male workers.

5. The core highlights the proportion of female workers within an occupational group.

- The occupational group category 'Not elsewhere classified' (as listed in the Pacific Data Hub dataset) is not included in this overview.
- The dataset is composed of various surveys. This may make cross comparisons between categories and years less accurate.
